In the late afternoon Matteo and I with our hosts and a French girl went home to have dinner and we made some handmade pasta to confirm our culinary supremacy:)




Wednesday, 20/12


It's traditional to go into the sauna, then into a bucket with ice cold water and finally into a warmer tub.


Or jump directly into the snow!

...be careful: it's slippery!!












Thursday, 21/12

This in italian actually means "cuddle" (Coccola)






Friday, 22/12
